**SUBJECT:** Fifty-One O One Restaurant Renovation  
Sealed Bid #23058

The Director of Facility Services requests a contract for the labor, materials, equipment, and services necessary for the Fifty-One O One Restaurant Renovation project in the Student and Culinary Arts Center (Building M). The current kitchen was last remodeled over 20 years ago. The new stainless-steel counters are going to be reconfigured to allow the students increased freedom of movement and allow the kitchen to run much more efficiently. This renovation project intends to upgrade the student-run kitchen to be consistent with a modern working kitchen at a highly rated restaurant.


In addition to the new stainless-steel counters, this renovation includes the purchase of two (2) pizza and sandwich tables, ten (10) heat lamps, an undercounter refrigerator unit, a separate undercounter freezer unit, and two (2) bun racks. Federal Vocational Education Equipment Grant (Perkins) dollars provide 100% of the funds for this purchase.


