The Computer Information Systems program seeks to upgrade two computer labs used by students in the Technology Building, Rooms E-175 and E-183. IT Services will cascade most of the existing computers to replace older systems in other areas of the College and will salvage parts from any remaining computers. Federal Vocational Education Equipment Grant (Perkins) dollars provide 100% of the funds for this purchase.

#### Notes:

- 1. The response from CDW-G failed to meet bid specifications in two critical areas. The computer system configured in the quote contained a Power Supply rated at only 210 watts instead of the required 500 watts, which would cause overheating and premature failure of system components. Secondly, the firm failed to submit a mandatory acknowledgement form certifying that it shall act in accordance with applicable federal grant certifications and provisions required by the Code of Federal Regulations, Title II, Part 200 and Appendix II.
- 2. The response from Office Depot failed to meet specifications for three important components: the system configured in the quote contained a Power Supply rated at only 250 watts; it did not include a solid-state hard drive; and it included a small form case rather than the specified standard (mid) tower case that fits existing lockdown devices.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The College administration recommends a contract award to Sehi Computer Products, Inc., for \$48,438.00 for Intel Core i7 Computer Systems as requested by the Computer Information Systems program, in accordance with the specifications of Sealed Bid #20514.
