1. Completion of an Associate in Applied Science in Nursing (ADN). **You can start before finishing your ADN or your NCLEX but you must finish your ADN/NCLEX before taking 400-level coursework.**
2. The nursing curriculum is 30 credits and a C (73%) or higher is required for the nursing curriculum.
3. The remaining requirements (general education & program requirement curriculum) may be completed through UM-Flint.
4. Students must earn a min. of 120 college credits (transfer & UM-Flint), and a min. of 30 UM-Flint credit hours.
5. Catalog and transfer credits are subject to change annually.

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# HFC-UM-Flint CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT OPTION

Beginning in the fall of 2025, HFC will be partnering with the University of Michigan-Flint (UM-Flint) to offer a unique program that allows students to simultaneously complete an Associate of Applied Science in Nursing (AAS) degree and a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree. Enrollment in the concurrent enrollment option is not required to participate in the HFC RN program. Students interested in participating in this option must be accepted into the RN (AAS) program at HFC. Students interested in applying to this concurrent enrollment option should contact a University of Michigan-Flint advisor. In addition to the HFC program and degree requirements, students enrolled in the collaboration agreement must complete extra coursework required for general education requirements at UM-Flint, as well as complete UM-Flint program requirements to earn the BSN degree. Courses required to satisfy UM-Flint's general education may be taken at either HFC or UM-Flint. Some of the courses may also apply to program and/or degree requirements at HFC. The table below outlines extra courses that will be required to complete the BSN degree. Some of these courses may also satisfy general education requirements at HFC.

Students will receive 30 credits once they pass their NCLEX. These 30 credits can be used towards the overall 120 college credits needed for the degree. Please make sure to work closely with a UM-Flint and HFC advisor.

**Students are strongly encouraged to work with a UM-Flint academic advisor to determine the likelihood of program completion and develop a plan for course completion that will result in timely completion of the degree.** Policies related to progression in HFC's program will apply. Students will be eligible for NCLEX testing and licensure upon completion of the HFC RN (AAS) program.

The curriculum plan for each cohort start includes required prerequisites, major requirements, MTA requirements, and the order of completing these courses at both institutions. With the plan below a student will graduate with the MTA, an Associates Degree in Nursing, and a BSN. This Advising Sheet lists all courses required to complete the HFC AAS (RN) degree, MTA, and the UM-Flint BSN-Completion degree.

The HFC/UM-Flint Collaborative Agreement requires 120 total credit hours of instruction to earn the BSN degree. Please see the Collaborative AAS/BSN Program agreement on file with the HFC Nursing Office to see the breakdown of credit hours and requirements by institution and degree.
